

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Family and friends will forever cherish their
2 memories of Bishop Othoe Stegall of Lubbock, who passed away on
3 February 17, 2009, at the age of 85; and

4 WHEREAS, A native of Afton, Bishop Stegall was born on
5 October 25, 1923, to Lee Franklin and Alice Ash Stegall; he served
6 his country with distinction during World War II as a member of the
7 U.S. Air Force 8th Fighter Squadron; and

8 WHEREAS, Following his military service, Bishop Stegall was
9 self-employed with an automotive upholstery business until 1950,
10 when he became an ordained minister; he was licensed to preach by
11 the Church of God at the age of 25, and in 1954 he was ordained as a
12 bishop; and

13 WHEREAS, Bishop Stegall shared his spiritual guidance with
14 churches in Stephenville, Brownfield, Sweetwater, Dallas and Fort
15 Worth, and Paris; he was pastor at Paris Church of God from 1960
16 until 1974 and later served as interim pastor for Pathway Church of
17 God; throughout his ministerial career, he inspired his
18 congregations with his leadership, faith, and vision; and

19 WHEREAS, Devoted to his family, he was married to his wife,
20 Pearl, for more than half a century, and together they raised three
21 children, David, Sue, and Pat; and

22 WHEREAS, Othoe Stegall will be deeply missed, but he leaves
23 behind a legacy that will forever be treasured by all those who
24 shared in the richness of his life; now, therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That the 81st Legislature of the State of Texas
2 hereby pay tribute to the life of Bishop Othoe Stegall and extend
3 deepest sympathy to the members of his family: to his wife, Pearl
4 Stegall; to his children, David Stegall and his wife, Anita, Sue
5 Boyd and her husband, Foy, and Pat Byas and her husband, Gerald; to
6 his grandchildren, Sharee and Jacky Howard, Alice Byas, and Shanna
7 and Chris Whitney; to his great-grandchildren, Baylee, Wade, and
8 Harlee Whitney and Lexi Howard; to his brother, Henry Rollins, Jr.;
9 to his sister, Mary Curby; and to his other relatives and friends;
