1 AN ACT

2 relating to the exemption of certain school districts from the
3 drainage charge imposed by a municipal drainage utility system.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 552.053, Local Government Code, as
6 effective April 1, 2009, is amended by adding Subsection (e) to read
7 as follows:

8 (e) Property owned by a school district located wholly or
9 partly in a municipality described by Section 552.044(8)(A) is
10 exempt from drainage charges under Section 552.047 and all
11 ordinances, resolutions, and rules adopted under this subchapter.

12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
16 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
