8	(h) The use of land does not change for purposes of
9	Subsection (a) solely because the owner of the land claims it as
10	part of the owner's residence homestead for purposes of Section
11	<u>11.13.</u>
12	(i) The sanctions provided by Subsection (a) do not apply to
13	land owned by an organization that qualifies as a religious
14	organization under Section 11.20(c) if the organization converts
15	the land to a use for which the land is eligible for an exemption
16	under Section 11.20 within five years.
17	(j) The sanctions provided by Subsection (a) do not apply to
18	a change in the use of land if:
19	(1) the land is located in an unincorporated area of a
20	county with a population of less than 100,000;
21	(2) the land does not exceed five acres;
22	(3) the land is owned by a not-for-profit cemetery
23	organization;
24	(4) the cemetery organization dedicates the land for a

- 1 cemetery purpose;
- 2 (5) the cemetery organization has not dedicated more
- 3 than five acres of land in the county for a cemetery purpose in the
- 4 five years preceding the date the cemetery organization dedicates
- 5 the land for a cemetery purpose; and
- 6 (6) the land is adjacent to a cemetery that has been in
- 7 existence for more than 100 years.
- 8 (k) In Subsection (j), "cemetery," "cemetery organization,"
- 9 and "cemetery purpose" have the meanings assigned those terms by
- 10 Section 711.001, Health and Safety Code.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 12 to a change of use of land that occurs on or after the effective date
- 13 of this Act. A change of use of land that occurs before the
- 14 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the
- 15 change of use occurs, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 16 purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
