- Sec. 43.152. 112TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT. [<del>(a)</del>] The voters of
- 11 the 112th Judicial District elect a district attorney.
- 12 [(b) The commissioners court of one or more of the counties
- 13 comprising the district may supplement the state salary of the
- 14 district attorney by an additional salary of \$4,800 a year. The
- 15 supplemental salary may be paid from the officers' salary funds of
- 16 the counties, if adequate. If the officers' salary fund of a county
- 17 is inadequate, the commissioners court shall transfer the necessary
- 18 funds from the general fund of the county to the officers' salary
- 19 **fund**.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
