1 AN ACT

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2 relating to a study examining the feasibility of providing health 3 services for women with postpartum depression.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- In this section, "postpartum depression" SECTION 1. (a) means a disorder with postpartum onset that is categorized as a mood disorder by the American Psychiatric Association in the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders, fourth edition, or a subsequent edition of that manual that the executive commissioner 10 of the Health and Human Services Commission by rule adopts to take the place of the fourth edition.
- 12 The Health and Human Services Commission shall conduct a 13 study examining the feasibility and effects of providing 12 months of health services under the Medicaid program to women who are: 14
  - (1)diagnosed with postpartum depression; and
- 16 (2) eligible for medical assistance under Chapter 32, 17 Human Resources Code, at the time of diagnosis.
- 18 Not later than September 1, 2006, the Health and Human 19 Services Commission shall provide a report to the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of the house of representatives, and 20 21 legislature that explains the conclusions of the study.
- 22 This Act takes effect September 1, 2005. SECTION 2.
