- 2 relating to the registration of persons engaged in certain fowl
- 3 operations; providing a criminal penalty.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 161, Agriculture Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 161.0411 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 161.0411. DOMESTIC AND EXOTIC FOWL REGISTRATION. (a)
- 8 A seller, distributor, or transporter of live domestic or exotic
- 9 fowl in this state shall register with the commission under this
- 10 <u>section</u>. The commission may exempt from registration a person
- 11 participating in a disease surveillance program recognized by the
- 12 commission.
- (b) A person may apply for a certificate of registration or
- 14 a renewal of a certificate of registration under this section by
- 15 submitting an application and an annual fee prescribed by the
- 16 commission. A person must complete an application for a
- 17 certificate of registration that includes a list of each location
- 18 at which the person conducts the sale, distribution, or
- 19 transportation of domestic or exotic fowl.
- 20 (c) The commission shall adopt rules to administer this
- 21 section, including rules relating to the testing, identification,
- 22 transportation, inspection, sanitation, and disinfection of
- 23 <u>domestic and exotic fowl</u>.
- 24 (d) The commission shall prescribe and collect an annual fee

- 1 for registration as a seller, distributor, or transporter of
- 2 <u>domestic or exotic fowl</u> in this state.
- 3 (e) The commission may set fees under this section in
- 4 amounts that do not exceed the amounts necessary to enable the
- 5 commission to recover the costs of administering this section.
- 6 (f) A person commits an offense if the person knowingly
- 7 violates this section or fails to comply with an order or rule
- 8 <u>adopted under this section.</u>
- 9 (g) An offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor
- 10 unless it is shown on the trial of the offense that the defendant
- 11 has been previously convicted under this section, in which event
- the offense is a Class B misdemeanor.
- SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2004, the Texas Animal
- 14 Health Commission shall adopt rules to administer Section 161.0411,
- 15 Agriculture Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
