- 6 SECTION 1. Section 26.3467(b), Water Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (b) A person who knowingly violates Subsection (a) commits
- 9 an offense that is punishable as provided by Section 7.156 for an
- 10 offense under that section.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 12 SECTION 3. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this
- 14 Act. For purposes of this section an offense is committed before
- 15 the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs
- 16 before that date.
- 17 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
- 18 Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed,
- 19 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
