1 AN ACT 2 relating to the Moore County Hospital District. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 1064.104(b), Special District Local Laws 5 Code, as effective April 1, 2011, is amended to read as follows: 6 (b) The hospital system may include: 7 (1)facilities for domiciliary care and treatment of 8 the sick or injured; 9 (2) facilities for outpatient clinics; 10 (3) dispensaries; 11 (4) facilities for geriatric [domisiliary] care\_ 12 including assisted living facilities and independent elderly 13 living facilities; 14 (5) <u>nursing</u> [convaloscent] home facilities; 15 domiciliaries and training (6) necessary nurses' 16 centers; 17 (7) blood banks; 18 (8) community mental health centers; research centers or laboratories; and 19 (9) 20 (10)any other facilities the board considers 21 necessary for hospital care. SECTION 2. Section 1064.110(a), Special District Local Laws 22 23 Code, is amended to read as follows: A construction or purchase contract that involves the 24 (a)

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expenditure of more than <u>the amount provided by Section 271.024</u>,
<u>Local Government Code</u>, [<del>\$15,000</del>] may be made only after advertising
in the manner provided by Subchapter B, Chapter 271, Local
Government Code.

5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
