

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the location of board meetings of certain economic
3 development corporations.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 504.054, Local Government Code, is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 Sec. 504.054. LOCATION OF BOARD MEETINGS. (a) Except as
8 provided by Subsection (b), the [The] board of directors of a Type A
9 corporation shall conduct each board meeting within the boundaries
10 of the authorizing municipality.

11 (b) If the authorizing municipality is located in a county
12 with a population of less than 30,000, the board of directors of a
13 Type A corporation may conduct a board meeting within the
14 boundaries of the county.

15 SECTION 2. Section 505.055, Local Government Code, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Sec. 505.055. LOCATION OF BOARD MEETINGS. (a) Except as
18 provided by Subsection (b), the [The] board of directors of a Type B
19 corporation shall conduct all meetings within the boundaries of the
20 authorizing municipality.

21 (b) If the authorizing municipality is located in a county
22 with a population of less than 30,000, the board of directors of a
23 Type B corporation may conduct a board meeting within the
24 boundaries of the county.

1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
5 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
