

AN ACT

2 relating to the board of hospital managers of the Lubbock County
3 Hospital District.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 1053.051, Special
6 District Local Laws Code, is amended to read as follows:

7 (a) The board consists of not fewer than six [~~five~~] and not
8 more than eight [~~seven~~] managers appointed as follows:

9 (1) one ex officio manager appointed by the Texas Tech
10 University Board of Regents; and

11 (2) the remaining managers appointed by the
12 commissioners court.

13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
17 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
