H.B. No. 598

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the designation of a segment of State Highway 21 in
3 Nacogdoches County as the Bob Luman Memorial Highway.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
6 is amended by adding Section 225.102 to read as follows:


7 Sec. 225.102. BOB LUMAN MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a) The portion
8 of State Highway 21 in Nacogdoches County between its intersection
9 with County Road 511 and its intersection with Farm-to-Market Road
10 95 is designated as the Bob Luman Memorial Highway. The designation
11 is in addition to any other designation.

12 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

13 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
14 designation as the Bob Luman Memorial Highway and any other
15 appropriate information; and

16 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
17 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.







IN RE: HB598 by Clardy (Relating to the designation of a segment of State Highway 21 in Nacogdoches County as the Bob Luman Memorial Highway.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) to design, construct, and erect highway markers designating a portion of State Highway 21 as the Bob Luman Memorial Highway, subject to Section 225.021 (c), Transportation Code.

Section 225.021 (c), Transportation Code, specifies that TxDOT may not design, construct, or erect the marker unless a grant or donation of funds is made to the department to cover the cost. Based on the analysis of TxDOT, it is assumed any duties associated with the implementation of the provisions of the bill could be absorbed within the agency's existing resources.
